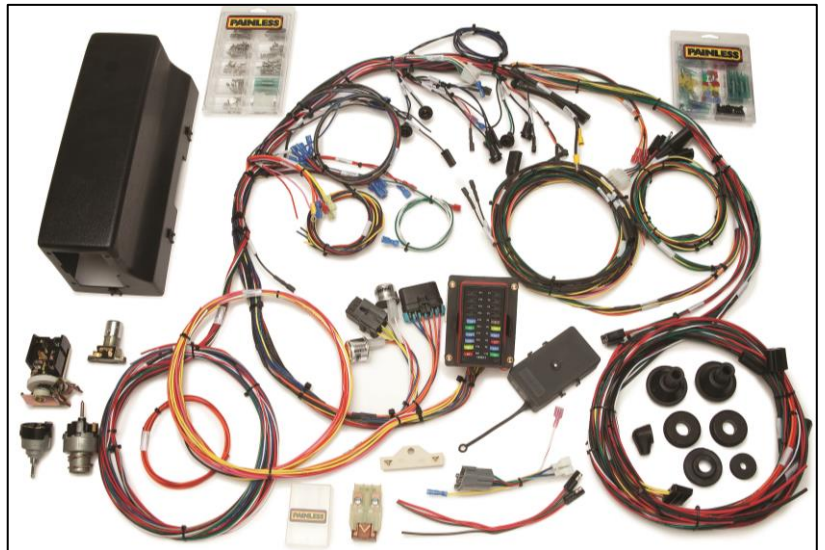

### **Direct Fit Harness for Early Broncos**

There's quite a following surrounding Ford's first rendition of the Bronco. Introduced in 1966, the little off-road SUV drew praise for its utilitarian abilities on and off the road. Little changed visually from their introduction through 1977, their final year of production however different drivetrain platforms as well as a handful of creature comfort accessories were added through the years.

Today, the Bronco is a favorite for hardcore off-roaders to enthusiasts that spend more time on the pavement cruising than the dirt. Regardless of where you fit in that ranking, most early Broncos are in dire need of a wiring update – and Painless has the solution.

Our Direct Fit harness for the early Broncos was designed with input from Bronco enthusiasts across the country! The 28 circuit harness includes a molded plastic glove box that not only replaces the factory cardboard one, it also mounts our weatherproof fuse block. There are also factory-style molded exterior light connectors, Ford turn signal connectors and a Ford dimmer switch connector. To ease installation the majority of factory connections are already pre-terminated and each wire is custom printed with the circuit identification as well as using Ford color codes for easy installation.
